Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist and coordinate the production of various projects using Agile development by ensuring team leads have the right resources to complete their projects.
- Create, implement, and maintain standard operating procedures (SOP) and process flow charts.

- Responsible for administrative tasks for meetings such as minutes, agenda, and tickets.
- Assist the Production Team in the creation of various reports as well as metrics monitoring, with emphasis on data collation and report creation.
- Set up the logistics (i.e., preparation, schedule) of in facility trials and other events.
- Establish a working relationship with third party academic institutions.
